

AGH University of Krakow
INFORMATION CLAUSE

Fulfilling the information obligation pursuant to art. 13 sec. 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (general regulation on data protection) [Journal U. UE L. 2016.119.1 of May 4, 2016], hereinafter referred to as: GDPR, we inform that:

1. The administrator of your personal data is the AGH University of Krakow, Al. Mickiewicza 30, 30-059 Kraków, hereinafter referred to as AGH;

3. Your data will be processed in order to register for a scientific event, communicate with participants in connection with the organization of a scientific event, document its course and to secure data in the event of any claims;
4. Your personal data will be processed:
 - a) pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. e) GDPR in connection with the Act of 20 July 2018 Law on Higher Education and Science (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2021, item 478, as amended) and the mission carried out by the University on its basis, which is conducting scientific activity, dissemination and multiplication of scientific achievements, participation in social development, as well as shaping civic attitudes and creating an economy based on innovation;
 - b) pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 letter b) of the GDPR, i.e. - processing is necessary for the conclusion and performance of the contract, the subject of which is participation in a scientific event;
 - c) pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 letter c) of the GDPR, i.e. processing is necessary for the Controller to fulfil its legal obligations in the field of financial, accounting and reporting documentation;
5. The recipients of your personal data may be:
 - a) entities to which the Administrator is obliged to provide data on the basis of applicable law,
 - b) entities providing services to the Administrator to the extent necessary to achieve the purposes for which your personal data is processed;
6. Your personal data may be transferred to state authorities, legal protection authorities (Police, Prosecutor's Office, Court) or local government authorities in connection with the conducted proceedings;
7. Your personal data will be processed only for the period necessary to achieve the purposes of personal data processing, i.e. for the period of organization and duration of the scientific event, as well as for the period when any claims become due and for the period resulting from the provisions of generally applicable law;
8. You have the right to request the Administrator to access your data and the right to rectify them, the right to delete data, the right to limit data processing and the right to object to their processing in cases and under the conditions specified in the GDPR;

9. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body - the Office for Personal Data Protection President pursuant to art. 77 of the GDPR (... each data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, (...) if he/she believes that the processing of personal data concerning him/her violates this regulation);
10. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making processes, including profiling;
11. Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary for the Administrator to achieve the purposes for which they were collected. The consequence of not providing personal data will be the inability to participate in the scientific event;
12. The Administrator reserves the right to take photos and videos during meetings, which can be used for promotional purposes in printed and electronic publications and in social media on the profiles of the Administrator's organizational units. According to Art. 81 sec. 2 points 2 of February 4, 1994 of the Act on Copyright and Related Rights (i.e. Journal of Laws 2021, item 1062, as amended), the dissemination of the image of a person who is only a detail of a whole, such as a gathering, landscape or a public event, does not require their permission.
